Riding at Night or Mornings? – Make Sure you are well lighted and visible.

For your safety and others ensure that you have working front and rear lights whenever you ride at twilight or in the dark. Most importantly you need to be seen clearly by passing traffic. This means you must have adequate and functional front and rear lights that can be clearly seen for 200m. Statistics show that being on the road at dawn or dusk are particularly dangerous times. Apart from a legal requirement it is for your own protection and safety that you are visible in all light conditions.
